Navigating to a waypoint HOWTO

Press the [FIND] button. Highlight the “Waypoints” icon and press the [ENTR].

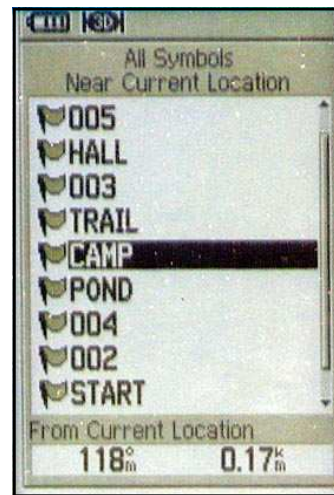


If the mini keypad appears, press [QUIT] and it will vanish.

Pressing [MENU] lets you sort waypoints by name or distance to you.

Highlight the waypoint you want to navigate to and press [ENTR].

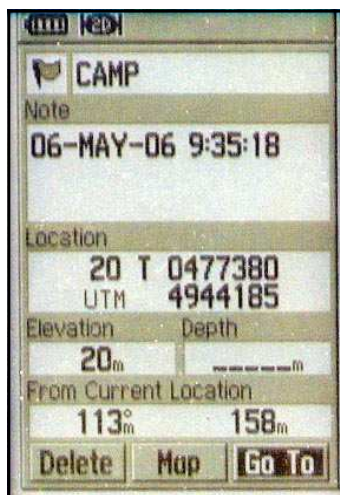

The waypoint page is displayed.

Highlight “Go To” at the bottom of the page and press the [ENTR].

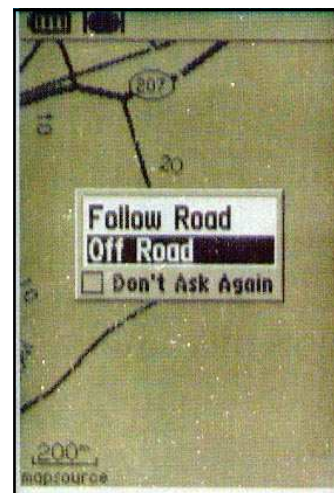

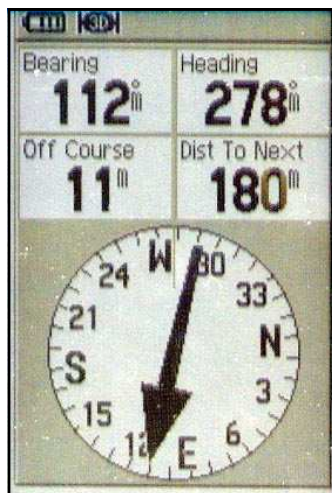
You will be prompted to either “Follow road” or “Off road”. Follow road plots a route to the waypoint using available roads. Off road plots a straight line route to the waypoint.

Choose “Off road” and press the [ENTR] button.

The compass page shows your bearing to the waypoint and your heading (when moving). The compass arrow points to the waypoint only when you are moving. Set your magnetic compass to the bearing and follow it. Read-just compass bearing as you go until “Dist to Next” is zero.



The map shows the user as a triangle. Direction user faces is only accurate when moving. Waypoint is connected to the user by a thick line. Your track is shown as a dotted line. Zoom with IN/OUT. Scroll with arrow keys. Press [QUIT] to reset the map.
