

**MEMORANDUM OF THE ASSOCIATION
OF
EASTERN SHORE GROUND SEARCH AND RESCUE TEAM**

1. The name of the Society is Eastern Shore Ground Search and Rescue Team (ESGSAR).

2. The mission of the Society is to seek to preserve life by assisting and augmenting Agencies of Jurisdiction search and rescue efforts in the search for the lost person(s) and assisting the Halifax Regional Municipality as per the RESAR agreement.

3. The objectives of the Society are:

- a. To provide the membership with training in ground search procedures.
- b. To conduct and assist in ground search operations in accordance with the Eastern Shore Ground Search and Rescue Team and the Nova Scotia Ground Search and Rescue Association Standards.
- c. To perform other related tasks that the Team might be called upon for, such as evidence searches.
- d. To acquire by way of grant, gift, purchase, bequest, devise, or otherwise, real and personal property and to use and apply such property to the realization of the objectives of the Team.
- e. To buy, own, hold, lease, mortgage, sell and convey such real and personal property as may be necessary or desirable in the carrying out of the objectives of the Team.

PROVIDED that nothing herein contained shall permit the Society to carry on any trade, industry or business and the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain to any of the members and that any surplus or any accretions of the Society shall be used solely for purposes of the Society and the promotion of its objectives.

PROVIDED, further, that if for any reason the operations of the Society are terminated or are wound up, or are dissolved and there remains, at that time, after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall be paid to some other charitable organization in Canada, having objectives similar to those of the Society.
